Spixworth Infant School

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Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the Summer Term. I hope you all had a good break over Easter. We have lots of exciting things coming up this term including all children going out on school visits. Could I remind you that Year 2 children will be involved in SATS activities throughout May and Year 1 and some Year 2 children will be involved in phonics screening tests that take place during week beginning June 15th. Please could I request that the children in these groups are in school every day and any necessary medical appointments are made for the afternoons. Thanks you.

Class Organisation

Every year the school has to consider how the classes are going to be organised for the following academic year and this is driven by the information we receive from Norfolk County Council about how many children we have coming into Reception. The numbers indicate that for the academic year 2015/16 we will again have mixed classes. Both myself and other members of staff have discussed in detail how the classes will be mixed and have decided that there will be a Reception class, a Reception/Year 1 class and two Year 1/Year 2 classes. Children in Reception will be organised into the classes by their date of birth. The Year 1 children will be split across the three classes taking into account gender, date of birth, ability and friendships. The Year 2 children will be split across both classes in the same way. Staff will be spending a considerable amount of time later this term considering the best makeup of the classes and deciding on which children should be in which class. We do consider friendships and don't go out of our way to separate friends, but this consideration is secondary to learning and ensuring we have classes who will learn well together. If you have any questions or comments to make about this please speak to me.

<u>New Classes</u>

Children will be spending time in their new classes on Tuesday 7th July. You will receive a letter informing you of who your child's new teacher will be on Monday 6th July.

Coffee Morning

This half term our Coffee Morning will be on Wednesday 22nd April from 9-9.30am. Ms Jordan would welcome your ideas/feedback on the amount and types of homework we send home. She will also be available to talk through how we teach phonics so if you still have any questions about this please do come along.

Reception Intake

If you have a child due to start Reception in September 2015 you will shortly be receiving a letter inviting you to a meeting for new parents on Thursday 2nd July. You will be able to choose whether you come at 9am or 2.15pm. At this meeting you will find out who your child's new teacher is and will have the opportunity to meet with them briefly over a cup of coffee. Your children are also invited into school for a short while on Tuesday 7th July so they can spend some time with their new teacher.

<u>Reports</u>

You will receive your child's school report on Friday 3rd July.

Opening Evening

Our annual Open Evening will be on Tuesday July 7th from 5pm-6.30pm. This will be a good opportunity to see the work your child has been doing this year, meet your child's current and new class teacher as well as gather information from the stalls set up in the hall from local services. There will also be a number of activities on offer during the evening for the children to join in with. You will not be able to discuss your child's report with their class teacher at this event.

School lunches

You may have noticed that the school lunch menu for the week is now displayed outside every classroom. There continues to be wide variety of choice and the vegetarian option is now a second choice rather than just a vegetarian version of the menu of the day. Children can choose from: Menu of the Day Vegetarian Menu of the Day School Packed Lunch Jacket Potato with cheese, tuna or ham.

Each main course comes with homemade bread, milk or water to drink and pudding of the day or fruit.

<u>Parking</u>

Just another reminder to park considerately when dropping off and picking up your child. Please do not park in the small car park opposite the school. This is a private car park for residents only and we have recently received a number of complaints. Parking around both our school and the Junior School is a focus of the local PSCO and Jan Moore will have a heightened presence over the coming weeks to address parking issues. The school car park should also not be used by parents or volunteers. I thank you for your help to keep our children safe.

Safety reminders

Please could I remind you that the children should not be playing on the climbing frames or trim trail equipment either before or after school as there are no members of staff on duty to supervise them. I have also spoken to the children about not playing football on the field before and after school and ask you to remind your children about this. There have also been a few near misses because children have been riding their bikes and scooters around the school. It is great that so many children are bringing them to school but please could I ask that they are not ridden around the school playground. This includes younger siblings.
